How to Submit Your Proposal - Proposal Extension... Due 4/30/10

(NOTE the TIMELINE designed to promote the conference details before summer). Forum sessions will include entrepreneurship symposia, panel discussions, and individual presentations organized as 50-minute sessions. Submit your proposal in Word format, or as content of an email, and e-mail it directly to the Consortium for Entrepreneurship Education at cashmore@entre-ed.org. We encourage use of classroom videos on CDs and teacher-friendly handouts. **We will confirm receipt of your proposal assuring your email was received.**

1. The proposal abstract **MUST** be no more than one typed page in length and **MUST** provide the following information which will be reproduced on our website and/or used in the conference :
2. Title of presentation (all caps)...short and catchy to attract an audience.
3. Name, position, organization, address, email, web page, and phone number of presenter(s).
4. Focus of the program content and objectives
5. Abstract describing purpose and content of the conference presentation. Please share experiences and ideas that can be replicated by conference participants. Participants want to take ideas and handouts home that they can use. (2-4 paragraphs maximum please)
6. A short bio on the presenter(s) and description of the organization represented. (1-3 paragraphs maximum)
7. **REQUIRED:** A brief program description...a two - three sentence program description to be used in the conference program.
